Local Action Group (LAG)

Integrated, multisectoral partnership at the local level

Local Action Group (LAG)

A coherent rural region

- Area of 10 – 100 000 inhabitants
- Territories of LAGs shall not overlap
- Municipalities themselves decide on LAG area they want to belong to

Standardization/certification of LAGs

- LAGs shall meet standards given and predefined by the Ministry
- LAG's bodies and processes shall be open and transparent
- a LAG cannot implement its Strategy without certification from Ministry

Local Action Group (LAG)

- Each LAG draws up a development strategy, which is subsequently implemented by selecting projects to be supported from the operational programmes
- 180 LAGs in Czech Republic (The commitment of the Czech Republic to the European Union is to have 165 approved LAGs)
- 84 strategies approved
- 2 strategies excluded
- the rest 94 in the approval process

Our success

- nearly **100% coverage** of rural areas by LAGs
- LAG network is **considered as a partner** of ministeries and other national authorities
- **LEADER/CLLD is included in 4 operational programmes**
 - RPD – Rural Development Programme (EAFRD)
 - IROP – Integrated Regional Operational Programme (ERDF)
 - OP Employment (ESF)
 - OP Environment (ERDF)





Community-led Local Development (CLLD)

- A new approach building on the principles of LEADER method widening possibilities for financing = MULTI-FUND financing
- The CLLD instrument is being implemented in the CR within the 2014-2020 programming
- Brings local actors together and allows actions to be tailor-made to social, environmental and economic challenges
- Many opportunities offering - to influence and develop new ideas and ways for quality of lives improvement and their implementation into practice

Community-led Local Development (CLLD)

Key features:

- place-based approach
- Bottom-up elaboration and implementation of strategies
- Area-based local development strategies
- Networking and cooperation (local public-private partnerships)
- Transparency, usefulness,
- Cooperation, Innovation,
- Integrated and multisectoral actions

LEADER in the CR- Practice examples


Successes:

- LAGs as administrators of ca 15 000 projects
- Growing capacity of LAGs to:
 - provide assistance and consultancy with project applications,
 - maintain interaction between different local actors, ...
- Local actors' competences, knowledge and awareness raising
 - Increasing familiarity of locals with project applications and with the practical operation of the whole system – projects applicants capable of submitting proposals on their own;

Setbacks:

- Open-mindedness and transparency of LAGs
- Capacity building of LAGs
- Monitoring and evaluation – duplication (LAG vs Paying Agency)

EAFRD = European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development


EMFF = European Maritime and Fisheries Fund

ESF = European Social Fund



RULES for cooperation projects in frame of CLLD

Aims:

- The technical cooperation support (preliminary costs – enable to verify the project ideas with potential partners, help to prepare the Cooperation contract,...)
- national cooperation
- transnational cooperation

Grant recipient: LAG, which was approved for the RDP

Project budget: 50 000 – 5 millions CZK (1 851 – 185 000 EUR)

Aid intensity: 50 % - 90 %, by type of activity

RULES for cooperation projects in frame of CLLD

- the subject of the project corresponds with the SCLLD objectives, the definition of the beneficiaries of grants and eligible costs
- project partners cooperate in solving common problems, needs of their LAG's areas or how to use / develop existing potential of the area
- cooperation project must bring added value of the cooperation
- the outputs from the action are common, all partner LAGs benefit from the project in the same/similar way

RULES for cooperation projects in frame of CLLD

- financing project from own resources first
- the project has to be finished up to 24 months from the signing of the Agreement
- project implementation in LAG territory only, exceptionally outside that territory
- The role of lead partner – coordinating LAG (communication with paying agency, signing the Agreement, making and dealing the changes)

RULES for cooperation projects in frame of CLLD

Eligible costs:

- the preliminary technical aid
- costs for managing the project
- education, information and awareness-raising actions designed to primary production and processing products
- other soft action in the field of education
- investments in local production
- investments related to the educational activities / information and tourist centre
- real estate purchase in connection with the project
